- 1. The above referenced Smartflex Piping shall be used for underground motor fuel piping installations and shall be installed in accordance only with the manufacturer's and UL safety requirements and limitations. The UL listing for this pipe requires that accessory fittings and sumps recommended by the manufacturer be used. This pipe may be used for stage II vapor recovery piping underground portion of vent lines provided the installation is permitted by NYSDEC.
- 2. All other aspects of the installation shall comply with the requirements of the New York City Building and Fire Prevention Code including 3RCNY §21-20. Installation shall also conform to the applicable requirements of the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

- 3. The above referenced Smartflex piping may only be installed by NUPI Americas, Inc. certified contractors who have been trained by NUPI or its nominated representatives. Contractors should have a current ID card denoting their training status.
- 4. When carrying out the electro fusion process, only the NUPI electro fusion machine with the error reporting feature may be used.
- 5. Only approved tools such as cutters, rounding clamps and pipe scrapers, which are described in the installation manual (as docketed in UL Report) may be used.
- 6. The NUPI Americas, Inc. shall maintain the listing with the Underwriters Laboratories, Inc. for motor fuels containing alcohol and other types of additives used as motor fuel. Follow up program of the UL shall be maintained.
- 7. The Certificate of Approval is issued upon condition that the material or equipment's technology does not violate any patent, trade name, trade secret or other intellectual right.
- 8. The Fire Department's conditions of approval shall be enumerated in the installation manuals and brochures which will be provided to New York City buyers and installers.
- 9. The above referenced NUPI's UL/ULC listed Smartflex semi-rigid pipe and fittings for use in vapor recovery piping applications, utilizing underground storage tanks and buried vapor return piping. The Smartflex pipe submitted for CARB testing was: TSMA-single wall pipe and TSMAD-double wall in straight lengths as listed in CARB Approval # 03-12A.
